Change lifestyle to keep BP under check - Dr. Ajay H. Kantharia

High blood pressure (hypertension) is the major risk factor for cardiovascular disease. Hence, in 2002, it was named 'the number one killer' by the World Health Organization (WHO) in the World Health Report. So every year, 17 May is dedicated to World Hypertension Day (WHD). The purpose of the WHD is to promote public awareness of hypertension and to encourage citizens of all countries to prevent and control the silent killer, the modern epidemic. Talking about it Dr. Ajay H. Kantharia from Mumbai says, "In short, the risk of stroke is four times greater and the risk of myocardial infarction (a heart attack) two times greater if you have high compared with normal blood pressure. This risk increases the higher the level of a person's blood pressure. Hypertension is a very common indeed and hence a major public health issue. Adequate treatment of high blood pressure lowers this cardiovascular risk towards normal levels. However, the biggest problem for controlling hypertension is compliance with treatment."



Urinary Bladder infections ignored due to lack of awareness

The urinary Bladder, which plays an important role by controlling urination, is one of the main portion of the human body that is often ignored by the people largely. Dr. Hemali Trivedi, Urologist, Saifee Hospital & Kohnoor said, "Over active bladder is not a normal problem and is common amongst the senior citizens. People suffer a lot of physical and mental problems as a result of this ailment because they feel that there is no cure for this." Urinary incontinence which is also known as involuntary urination is not very common and hence aren't aware of it. This also causes a lot of distress amongst the people suffering from it. This also stops socialising because of it further going into depression. Lot of awareness is required towards this ailment for people to come ahead and seek treatment for this. Trivedi further informs that the treatment initially involves behavioural therapy and medicines are prescribed only when this doesn't work.
